

North Fork Area Transit, over the past few years, implemented many transit services, serving a variety of carefully designed options to meet the travel needs of the community – the elderly and disabled, tripper service for school-age kids, and employees.

Our Services.

Our **TeleLift** service continues to grow. It primarily serves seniors and people with disabilities traveling to work, medical, and shopping trips.

We operate a **Regional** route with service from Norfolk to Great Dane in Wayne designed to get Norfolk residents to work in Wayne. Bus schedules revolve around the shift changes.

Services Returning in the Future

ForkLift, the fixed route bus service will add a great option for existing Telelift riders as well as local school and college students.

NiteLift would operate evenings and late nights to help people get to and from work and also provides a safe ride home from local bars.

Tripper service is a set of routes that operate in the morning and afternoon and focus on K-12 school children. These routes are also open to the general public.
